## Historical Trip for Orphan, destitute and neglected children

Veerashaiva College has LEAD (Leader Accelerating Development) cell which is a part of Deshpandey Foundation started in 2015 through an MOU from then our LEAD students have been actively taking up several projects and other LEAD activities. And these students are able to solve the problems of underprivileged and the needy, as a result of which they have developed leadership qualities like self-confidence, courage, determination, social concern and decision making etc.

On 25<sup>th</sup> October 2015, LEAD took 80 destitute children to historical and educational trip to Hampi and Hospet . This was the first time in the history of destitute homes this kind of activity taken up according to Director of children protection unit, Ballari district, Sri Mohammed Sarovar.

In 2018 February 19<sup>th</sup> LEAD in association with children protection unit, Ballari district, once again has taken to historical places like Hampi and Hospet for educational tour. 46 boys 51 girls of destitute homes were taken to trip. V VSangha has arranged two separate buses for both boys and girls. It shows its service mindedness. This is the second visit in the history of destitute homes of Karnataka State. The LEAD has undertaken a trip for those children along with Co-ordinator Dr. H. B. Jalajakshi and 8 LEAD students. The chairman of Veerashaiva College Mr.GonalRajashekarGoud and the Principal Dr. G. Rajashekar expressed best wishes for the trip undertaken by the LEAD.

The LEAD students explained the historical background of the Kamalapur Museum, Stone Chariot, Music Stone , Lotus Mahal, Queen Bath and Park so that children could become aware of it. Also visited temples like HampiVirupaksheshwara, Kodandarama, UgraNarasimha etc. Children enjoyed by seeing T B Dam, the park and the Fountain. The LEAD co-ordinator Dr. H. B. Jalajakshi, The director of defence unit Sri Mohammed Sarovar& staff, and LEAD students Shirisha, Kulkarni, Ganesh,MeghaKapli,Farzana, Kalyani, Pavitra and others were present.
