Annual Report for the Year 2020-21

I am very much pleased to present a brief report of my prestigious college for the academic year 2020-21. The academic calendar of events was prepared by IQAC in consultation with all the heads of the departments for effective implementation of curricular, co-curricular and extension activities in scheduled time. During this academic year 1699 students have joined for various UG and PG programmes of which 139 students have enrolled for PG programmes. Orientation programme was organized for newly enrolled students on 24.12.2020. About three faculty have acted as BOS members of VSK University, Ballari and seven staff members as chairmans of Board of Examinations. The institution has introduced four add on certificate courses and one diploma course in tourism studies, tally, human rights and social forestry. About, 137 students have enrolled for these five courses and completed the course successfully. The college encouraged students to undertake field work / project work. About 593 students of final year have completed project work in their respective fields. The pass percentage of term and examination is excellent. In all the programmes pass percentage is above 90.

I feel happy to say that 08 National Level E-webinars and offline National seminars have been organized under various themes. These seminars are organized to provide supplementary information and an opportunity for experiential learning.

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Many of our teachers have published articles in National and International Journals. About 07 teachers from all the streams have published articles in popular journals. About 02 teachers published books and chapters in edited volumes of books published. Blood donation camp is organized by NSS units for which we received appreciation letter from blood bank, VIMS, Ballari. We organized extension activities for creating awareness among rural people on social issues. Awareness programme on use of solar energy is organized by the Department of Physics at Sreedhargadda Village. The Department of Botany has organized awareness programme on Swatcha Bharata at Allipur Village. Awareness Programme on COVID-2019 is held in collaboration with District Authority, Ballari. Awareness on food adulteration is held at Shanavasapura by the Department of Chemistry. NSS units have organized traffic awareness programme in the cantonment area of the city. At present the college is having 08 MOUs with different HEIs and Govt organizations. Totally, 10 activities are conducted under MOU like Teacher Exchange and Student Exchange programmes. About 385 students have received scholarship from the Department of Social Welfare, Ballari. The institution has a distinctive practice namely helping, differently abled and economically weaker section students. Under this scheme, five blind girls are adopted by the institution and provided them free education till the completion of under graduation. Endowment prizes are introduced by the philanthropist to motivate and reward the achievements of students. Capacity building and skill enhancement activities are also organized by the institution. The Institution has organized special talks on competitive exams by inviting experts. S. Sai mohan Reddy


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won a prize in Smt Usha M Jali Memorial Intercollegiate science lecture contest held at ASM College for women, Ballari. About 227 students have participated in sports activities. Faculty Development programme is organized by the institution for teachers and non teaching staff. About 07 teachers of four departments have attended FDP organized by different educational institutions in india. Shobha Y, Department of BCA attended FDP at Dr.C.V.Raman, University, Bangalore, held under the theme " Research PRO the comprehensive Research Technique" from 24.05.2021 to 30.05.2021. Dr HB Jalajakshi, Department of Sociology attended FDP organized by academic research group Kolar under the theme Policy initiative and quality enhancement in higher education from 05.05.2021 to 11.05.2021. 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

Annual Report for the Year 2018-19

It gives me an immense Pleasure to place a brief annual report of the college for the academic year 2018-19. Due to paucity of time I will just focus on some of the important events and achievements established in Curricular and Co-curricular activities.

Veerashaiva College, Ballari is the premier higher educational institution of Hyderabad Karnataka region. It was started in 1945 in pre-independence era with a holistic aim of providing quality education to everyone. This institution laid a strong foundation to the lives of lakhs of students in its 74 years of meaningful service. Many of our students have raised to national and international level. I would like to mention a few luminaries who brought the name and fame of the college with their achievements throughout the world.

They are Smt Dr. Sudhamurthy, chair person, Infosys Foundation, Bengaluru, Late Prof.U.R.Rao, a great space scientist and former president of ISRO, Sri Prabhakar Reddy, Director General of Police, west Bengal, Sri Koti linganagouda, Retired IAS officer, Prof Syed Ibrahim, Senior Scientist, Nuclear Medicine at Kentucky, USA and others.

As per the calendar of events of Vijayanagar Sri Krishnadevaraya University, Ballari. The college re-opened on 01.06.2018. During 2018-19, 1964 students have taken admission for UG and PG courses of which 611 are girls. Nearly Half of the total strength of the college have opted science courses for this academic year 2018-19.

It is a good sign that the importance of basic science has been increasing in upward direction.

An orientation Programme was organized for newly enrolled students to introduce rules and regulations of the institution and to provide information regarding fee structure, learning facilities, training programmes, career guidance and counseling, cells and committees, examination system, mentor system, special learning facilities to slow

learners etc. Prof S.A. Patil Registrar (Academic) VSK University, Ballari inaugurated the programme. I feel proud to announce that five students of our college have secured ranks in the examinations held by VSK University, Ballari in 2017-18. They added colorful feather to the cap of the Veerashaiva College by showing outstanding performance in the examinations. On behalf of the Management of v.v sangha, Governing body principal and staff. I congratulate all the five rank holders.

Miss Labna Khathun Secured 2nd rank in B.Sc with 91.74%, Sri Ajit T.K, secured 8th rank with 87.62% in B.Sc, Miss Vaishnavi K has bagged 3rd rank in B.A with 83.92% of marks. Miss Jeetheshwari secured 6th rank in B.A with 83.21% and Miss Musani Poojith secured 5th rank in BCA with 87.62% of marks.

IQAC has organized a two day national seminar under the theme "Enhancement of Quality in Higher Educational Institutions and The Role of IQAC" on 15th and 16th February 2019 for which we received Rs 75000/- grant from NAAC. Ours is the only college in the whole Jurisdiction of VSK University which was selected by NAAC and released a grant of Rs 75000/-. The significance of the seminar is that the former Director of NAAC Prof H.A Ranganath inaugurated the seminar and delivered key note address. About 192 teachers and research scholars Participated in it. Among them 48 delegates presented papers on issues, problems and prospects of Higher Education in India. Prof Seshagirirao, Govt First Grade College, Jayanagar, Bangalore and Prof.B.S.Srikanta, Principal, Sindhi College, Bangalore were invited as Resource Persons.

A one day state level workshop on "Research Methodology and field work" was held on 05.02.2019 by the department of sociology.

The Veerashaiva College was started by the philanthropists of our community on the foundation of humanitarian values.


