Dr.N.S.Lingegouda, Scientist, Forensic Science Laboratory, Davanagere, delivered a talk on "The Role of Forensic Science in detecting Criminals" on 20/03/2018. This programme is organized by the Departments of Sociology and Zoology in association with IQAC. In his speech, he opined that violation of norms has been increasing due to sudden changes in the life style of the people. The detection of certain cases of crime is a very difficult task. It is crucial to prove the crime within the frame work of judicial system before destroying the evidences. Fibers, Soil, Air, Gunshot, Wood, etc., are useful to search evidences. Collection and analysis of medical samples serve the task of producing facts in the court. Many criminal cases remained pending as the laboratories of Forensic Science are not in required number. Therefore, he insisted on the Government to establish more and more laboratories to speed up the disposal process of criminal cases. He has displayed pictures of evidences and different types of forensic tests conducted on diverse cases of crime.
