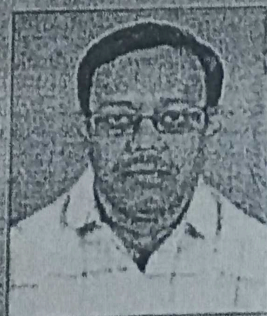
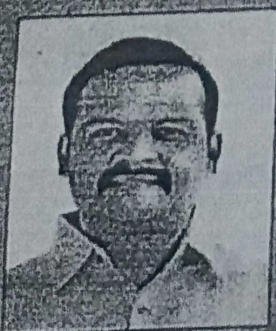
Department of Sociology Organizes National e Webinar on Socio-Economic Effects of COVID 19 and Remedies

In this backdrop, the present eWebinar is imperative to focus on different faces of pandemic, effective nature, magnitude, abuses and remedies.



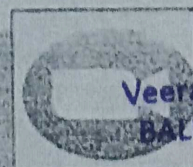

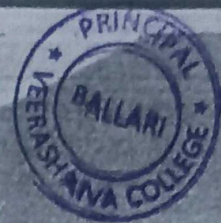




One day National Level e-webinar on Socio-economic Effects
