

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#### Recommendations

IQAC cell of the college is functioning in a systematic manner and is maintaining the records. However, it is suggested that each department need to have a coordinator other than the HOD of that department who could liaison with the college level IQAC Coordinator.

Department level QAC s shall function in a pro-active manner and their activities shall be properly documented.

- It is desirable if the calendar of events prepared at the College level should include co-curricular and extra-curricular activities also.
- The college should take initiatives to attract more faculty members towards research by organizing workshops/awareness programs on research prospects and funding opportunities available. For this the college could associate with universities/UGC/CSIR/AICTE/KCSTE etc.
- It is observed that the college is having a well equipped central library. But the usage rate seems to be very low. Steps should be taken to improve this.
- Some departments have inadequate classrooms and IT infrastructure (Computers & LCD projectors). This should be addressed at the earliest. Potential research departments shall be provided with necessary lab/ICT facilities.
- Buildings in the college should be made disable friendly by providing ramps and wheel chair.
   Necessary safety measures including installation of fire extinguishers shall be ensured in laboratories.
- It is observed that there are no serious efforts taken to maintain data on student progression in the
  departments with documentary evidence. Efforts need to be taken to maintain documents related to
  student progression.
- The placement cell activities have to be strengthened. Efforts have to be taken to identify
  prospective employers and job fairs/ placement drives shall be conducted.
- Feedback shall be followed by proper analysis and actions. An on line feedback system may be devised and links may be provided in the website.

## Academic and Administrative Audit Report 2020-21.

Curricular Planning and Implementation	All the teachers prepare teaching plans and devise strategies for the implementation of curriculum. The Principal and senior teachers monitor implementation of curriculum and guide the teachers in using suitable teaching methods.
Curriculum Enrichment	Teachers are using ICT in delivering curriculum. Add on courses are implemented for the benefit of students.
Feedback System	Feedback is collected by administering structured questionnaires to all the stake holders chosen randomly. The collected feedback is analyzed by the committee and the outcomes were placed in the meeting called by the Principal and action was taken for reformation in the areas in which the performance of selected teachers and bodies was not satisfactory. The staff concerned were informed to correct the problems.

Student Enrolment and Profile	Good.
Catering to Student Diversity	The Institution has taken appropriate measures to assess the learning levels of students and initiated special programmes for improving the performance of slow learners and also introduced specific programmes for advance learners. The teacher and students ratio is 1 : 26. The teachers paid personal attention to learning related problems of the slow learners.
COORDINATOR, Quality Assurance Cell (IOAC),	The Institution sincerely put its efforts to create student centric environment through encouraging and promoting participative learning. The students are involved in project works and skill development activities. Teachers working in science, computer science, and commerce departments are using ICT regularly. Mentor system is implemented effectively for counseling and solving the problems of mentees. The mentors discuss the problems pertaining to study, examination, internal test and other career related matters.

Teacher Quality	The teachers are appointed to the vacant posts as per the existing workload. About 16 UGC permanent teachers 49 guest faculty are on the roll. Of which 17 teachers possessed Ph.D degree. Around 30% of teachers have more than 10 years of teaching experience. The service experience of about 50% teachers is between 5 to 10 years. And 10% of the teachers have less than 5 years of teaching experience.
Evaluation Process and Reforms	The Institution constituted a separate committee to look after examination and internal tests. The committee conducted mandatory tests and examinations transparently according to the schedule of affiliated university. The evaluated answer scripts of internal and unit tests are returned to students with marginal and global comments to know their performance and mistakes in answering and collected back by the teachers concerned.
Student Performance and Learning Outcomes	PO's, SPO's and CO's are uploaded on the website for the reference of stakeholders. Pass percentage of students in all the programmes is quite excellent except in fourth semester of PG studies in chemistry. Measures like remedial classes are organized to improve the performance of slow learners in examinations.

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#### Recommendations

IQAC cell of the college is functioning in a systematic manner and is maintaining the records. However, it is suggested that each department need to have a coordinator other than the HOD of that department who could liaison with the college level IQAC Coordinator.

Department level QAC s shall function in a pro-active manner and their activities shall be properly documented.

- It is desirable if the calendar of events prepared at the College level should include co-curricular and extra-curricular activities also.
- The college should take initiatives to attract more faculty members towards research by organizing workshops/awareness programs on research prospects and funding opportunities available. For this the college could associate with universities/UGC/CSIR/AICTE/KCSTE etc.
- It is observed that the college is having a well equipped central library. But the usage rate seems to be very low. Steps should be taken to improve this.
- Some departments have inadequate classrooms and IT infrastructure (Computers & LCD projectors). This should be addressed at the earliest. Potential research departments shall be provided with necessary lab/ICT facilities.
- Necessary safety measures including installation of fire extinguishers shall be ensured in laboratories.
- It is observed that there are no serious efforts taken to maintain data on student progression in the
  departments with documentary evidence. Efforts need to be taken to maintain documents related to
  student progression.
- The placement cell activities have to be strengthened. Efforts have to be taken to identify
  prospective employers and job fairs/ placement drives shall be conducted.

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## External Academic & Administrative Audit 2018-19

Veerashaiva College was established in Pre-Independence era in 1945 by the philanthropists of Veerashaiva Community. Its objective was to provide higher education to all the sections of society without any discrimination and at an affordable rate of fees. Over the years the College has updated the infrastructure and provided diversity in learning. It has widened the horizon of learning by introducing a few more PG Courses in Science stream.

The Committee identified the following things during the time of visit. On the basis of comprehensive scrutiny and the data provided by the Departments, Staff and Students, the AAA report is prepared and submitted to the Principal.

- The institution has been consistently pursuing its stated vision and mission
  of consciously creating and recreating an enabling overall learning
  environment from time to time to face unpredictable changes and challenges
  that are being engendered by the latest developments in society, economy
  and polity.
- 2. The CBCs pattern was followed in UG and PG courses.
- 3. Most of the departments have well experienced, highly qualified and talented teachers. Some of the teachers have actively involved in research activities and publication of articles. However, vacant posts need to be filled up to minimize the appointment of guest faculty.
- The teachers are sufficiently encouraged to augment interest in research.
   The Governing Council and IQAC have provided ICT facility to get online data.
- It is observed that a large number of staff and students participated in rallies, outreach programmes and extension activities.
- 6. Student Supportive Services like hostel, swimming pool, indoor stadium, gym, browsing centres, language lab, e-journals etc., are regularly accessible to the students' community. The students staying in the hostel requested to supply sweet water for all purposes.

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- 7. The Central library of the College consists of variety of books including the rarest of the rare books and journals that are useful for competitive examinations. Vacant posts in the library should be filled up at the earliest to provide still better service to the students.
- 8. The Science teachers have been using ICT in their classes regularly. But the teachers in Commerce and Arts are to be encouraged to make use of ICT in their classes for effective teaching.
- 9. The College has a vast playground to train students in all types of games and sports. But the participation of students and performance level is not up to the mark. It is suggested to attract the students towards sports and games and motivate them to make use of facilities on the campus for the development of personality.
- Alumni Association has been functioning in the campus. Initiation shall be made for its registration.
- 11. The College has entered into MOU with some of the local Higher Educational Institutions to encourage and implement students exchange and teachers exchange programmes. It is suggested to invite the teachers from other departments under this scheme to enhance the quality of education.
- 12.12 students of CBZ combination have undergone soil testing training organized in collaboration with the Department of Central Soil and Water Conservation and Research, Ballari.
- 13.A NAAC sponsored two day national seminar was organized by IQAC on 15<sup>th</sup> & 16<sup>th</sup> February 2019 under the theme "Enhancement of quality in Higher Education – The Role of IQAC".

A Two day Self Financed National Conference was held on 21<sup>st</sup> & 22<sup>nd</sup> March, 2019 by the Department of Zoology under the theme "Environmental Pollution – Causes and Remedies".

A One Day State Level Workshop was conducted on 5th February, 2019 under the there "Research Methodology and Field Work".

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- 14. It is a best practice that most of the departments in the College provided ample opportunities to students for experiential learning.
- 15. The students have been encouraged to participate in Seminars and Conferences. Some of them have presented posters and papers.
- 16. The result turnover in all the streams is found satisfactory. The pass percentage in Arts is above 80%, whereas it is above 70% in Science and above 60% in commerce.
- 17. The scholarship facility is availed by weaker section students. The amount of scholarships has been disbursed to the students on time. Some of the students have received scholarships from JSW and other organizations. The students are also provided scholarship by the panchayat raj institutions and local bodies for purchasing books.
- 18.IQAC has framed policies for the improvement of quality of education. It has prepared plan of action and setup benchmarks to initiate quality developing activities.
- 19.Self employment and entrepreneurship skill development workshop is organized in association with District Small Scale Industries Centre. The students are given training in producing tiny products and information on financial assistance to take up self employment activities.
- 20. Feedback is collected, analyzed and utilized for the improvement of quality.
- 21. The performance of the students in all the activities is observed and evaluated by the mentors concerned. Simultaneously, a separate counselling is conducted for slow and problematic learners to improve their level of performance and participation in classroom activities.
- 22. Two teachers have been awarded Ph.D. Degree for their research work.
- 23. Some of the schemes like Remedial Classes, Bridge Courses and Celebration of Yoga Day are undertaken for capacity building among the students.

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- 24. Facilitating Centre for Civil Service Examinations has been conducting special classes to prepare the students for Civil Service Examinations. UPSC syllabus related study material and books are kept in the centre for the use of students with seating arrangements.
- 25. Cultural Day and Sports Meet are conducted at the institutional level to support and blossom hidden potentialities within the students and encourage their participation in cultural and sports activities.
- 26. Some of the teachers have presented papers in national and international conferences. It is suggested to increase the number of teachers participating in seminars and workshop.
