About 65 million people speak Urdu worldwide, of which, 52 million speakers reside in India. Within India, there are over 3000 Urdu language publications, including over 400 daily newspapers. Such a important form of language was introduced in Veerashaiva College in 1945 itself.

Prof. R.K.Rehaman laid firm foundation for the Department of Urdu. It was he who had taken the name of the Department to highest level.
